I refer to your information request dated and received 30<sup>th</sup> August 2018, our ref: 23611.

Please find Fife Council's response below.

In Fife privately funded care home residents who are in Local Authority Care Homes are all charged the same rate regardless of which particular care home it is. The charge to the individual is £780 per week. This charge is made up of the weekly unit cost of £954 per week less a Free Personal Care allowance of £174.

I trust this meets your requirements.

If you are not satisfied with the way we have handled your request, you have the right to request a review of the decision.
