In regards to private care homes, Section 17, of the of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 provides that Scottish public authorities are not obliged to comply with a request for information if the authority does not hold the information.

The Council does not hold records of the information you have requested, therefore we refuse this part of your request.

The information which we can provide is as follows:

If a resident is self funding (assessed as having capital in excess of £27,250) then the contractual arrangement in place is between the Provider and the individual. DHSCP staff would not be informed of the cost of the placement and our only role in these placements is putting in place a Route 2 contract to enable FPNC to be paid (currently FPC £174 and FNC £79 or both £253).

There are 11 self funder in the LA care homes and they are charged £710 per week.

## **Your Right to Appeal**

If you are unhappy with this reply you may require the Council to review its actions and decisions in relation to your request.

The requirement for review must:-

- be in writing or other permanent form (please address it to me);
- state your name and give an address for correspondence;
